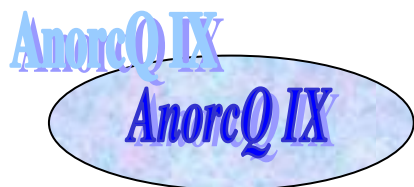
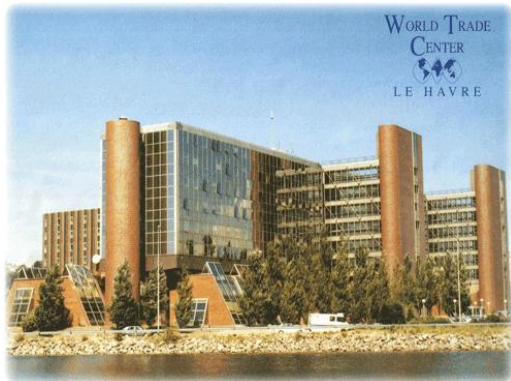


Ninth Anglo-Norman Organic Chemistry Colloquium

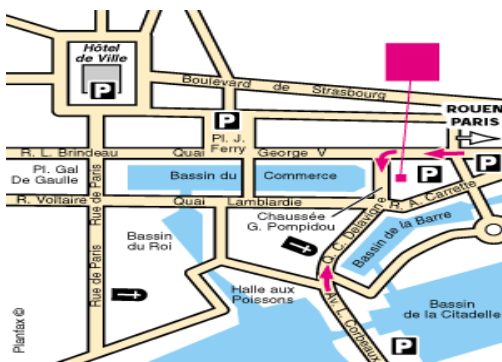
