

EUROPE DAY 2022 AWARDS

Regulation

For this first edition, the Europe Day competition aims to:

- stimulate students' reflection on Europe;
- reward a collective work;
- highlight innovative proposals.

The theme chosen for the 2022 competition is : **the borders of Europe.**

Borders are defined in a broad sense. They can be geographical, legal, cultural, philosophical, political, sociological or economic.

All the disciplines that can enrich the reflection and give rise to proposals for innovative actions at the level of the city of Le Havre are welcome.

To participate, you just have to:

- be a student in Le Havre (valid student card);
- form a working group between 2 and 5 students (groups can be composed of students registered in different higher education institutions);
- produce a collective text of 2,500 to 3,000 words;
- Appendices such as a bibliography or graphic illustrations may be added to the text ;
- Works in French, English and German are accepted.

Applicants must submit their work by April 30, 2022 to concours-europe@lehavre.fr specifying, for each participant:

- Last name, first name, institution, nationality, e-mail address, telephone number.

The works will be selected according to the following criteria:

- quality of the reflection on the proposed subject;
- innovative character of the proposals;
- link with the city of Le Havre;
- link with current events;
- quality and rigor in the writing.

Three prizes will be awarded:

- City of Le Havre Prize (trip to Germany for the winning team)
- Campus Prize (visit to a European institution)
- Maison de l'Europe Prize (300 € La Galerne vouchers)
